Subject: Notification of Correction of Noncompliance

Dear James Layman:

The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Spearman Independent School District (ISD) of the correction of noncompliance identified in the **Cyclical Desk Review**.

Spearman ISD received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated 4/30/2024 listing the following areas of noncompliance:

- IEP Development: Development of Present Levels of Academic Achievement and Functional Performance (PLAAFP)
34 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) § 300.320(a)(1)
- IEP Development: Measurable Annual Goals
34 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) § 300.320(a)(2)(i)

A plan for correction of the noncompliance was included in your corrective action plan. Subsequently, the local education agency (LEA) was required to submit documentation to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) verifying correction for the abovementioned noncompliance. The documentation submitted by the LEA indicated that this area of noncompliance has been addressed, and the noncompliance has been corrected. Therefore, no further action on this issue is required at this time.
