

Teachers are the single most important in-school factor impacting student outcomes






Texas Instructional Leadership (TIL) invests in instructional leaders to grow teachers and improve the student experience



TIL builds instructional leader capacity in four practice areas








Materials Internalization &

Observation & Feedback builds IL capacity to routinely observe teacher classroom instruction and provide actionable coaching & feedback




Data Driven Instruction trains ILs to facilitate Teacher PLCs analyzing student work and identifying strategies to address student learning needs







Hillsboro ISD has engaged in Texas Instructional Leadership coaching through Region 12 ESC for the past four years.




Hillsboro has been on a multi-year journey to improve student outcomes leveraging all TIL practice areas
