Appendix C—Statutory References

Texas Administrative Code (TAC)

Select chapters of the accountability manual are adopted as part of the Texas Administrative Code. With the publication of this manual, the Texas Education Agency (TEA) filed a Commissioner's Rule amendment to 19 TAC §97.1001, Accountability Rating System; and incorporated provisions from 19 TAC §97.1005, Results Driven Accountability, which would be repealed, with the Office of the Secretary of State. These rules adopt Chapters 1–12 of the 2023 Accountability Manual giving legal standing to the state rating processes and procedures.

Following a 30-day public comment period, the final adoption took effect in November 2023. Once effective, the rules are made available online at https://tea.texas.gov/about-tea/laws-and-rules/texas-administrative-code/19-tac-chapter-97.
